It will make suggestions to change and update the value-method codex of the ministry.

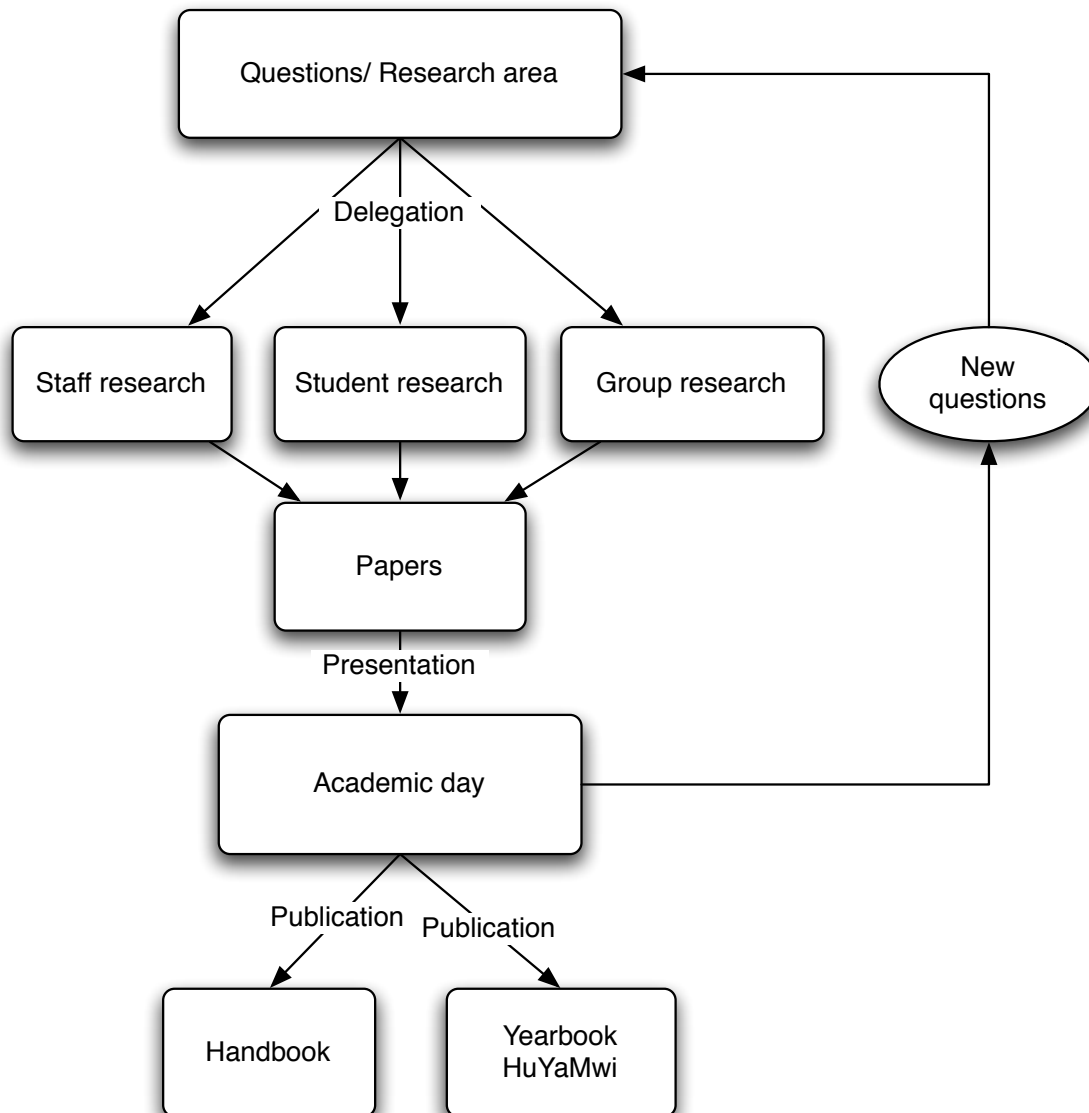
It will participate in all evaluation teams (see §19)
